### **Fascinating walk-through Dufry Main Shop at EuroAirport Basel-Mulhouse-Freiburg**

In September 2005 Dufry signed an agreement with the Airport Authorities to operate additional commercial space at EuroAirport Basel-Mulhouse-Freiburg.

In the first four months of 2006, passenger figures at EuroAirport have reached 1.1 million reflecting a growth of 30% in comparison with 2005. The Main Shop with a size of 800 m<sup>2</sup> replaces the existing Duty Free Shop. It opened its doors on March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2006. The 200 m<sup>2</sup> Fashion Shop started operations on May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2006.

The new concept of the Main Shop is perfectly adapted to the passenger flow and is the first of its kind in the airport. Passengers can walk into an open spacious luxury area and enjoy a wide assortment ranging from Perfumes & Cosmetics, Watches & Jewellery, Tobacco, Spirits and Food to gifts, confectionery, music and electronics, toys, souvenirs, fashion and accessories.

For EuroAirport, the main Dufry Shop is also an excellent example of optimal use of infrastructure space and is the fruit of successful collaboration between EuroAirport and Dufry.

The shops offer a large number of leading brands, such as Calvin Klein, Ferragamo, Hugo Boss, Lacoste and Tommy Hilfiger in fashion, Kipling and Samsonite for travel accessories, Misaki, Morellato, Swarovski and Hot Diamonds for jewellery, Burberry, Carrera, Diesel, Dior, Emporio Armani, Giorgio Armani, Gucci, Max Mara, Police, Prada, Ralph Lauren and Ray Ban for sunglasses, Caran d'Ache, Montblanc and Recife for writing instruments, Breitling, Calvin Klein, Flik Flak, Gucci, Jeep, Nivada, Police, Raymond Weil, Swatch, Tag Heuer, Tommy Hilfiger and Zeno for watches.

On December 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2005 Dufry opened a new Duty Free shop in the departure area to provide additional opportunity to benefit from Duty free shopping. The shop has a size of 200 m<sup>2</sup> and stocks a traditional Duty Free assortment of perfumes & cosmetics, liquor & fine wines, tobacco, gifts and confectionery.
