Dufry signs contract to operate 3,345 sqm of duty free commercial area at Moscow-Sheremetyevo international airport

Dufry has signed a 7-years contract with OAO International Airport Sheremetyevo to operate duty free shops at Moscow-Sheremetyevo airport after an international tender process.

Dufry will operate an area of 3'345 sqm of retail surface in the duty free area of Sheremetyevo's new Terminal 1. The Sheremetyevo operations, which are expected to open in 2007, comprise all product categories and Dufry will be responsible for the design, layout and fitting of the shopping area. Moscow-Sheremetyevo airport is one of the main airports in the region and welcomes around 8.5 million international passengers each year and the new Terminal 1 will handle 2.5 million international departure passengers.

Julian Diaz, CEO of Dufry, commented: "We are very excited about to possibility to operate in Sheremetyevo. We will be able to design and implement a modern and attractive shopping area based on our extensive retail expertise. Our goal is to create one of the prime travel retail possibilities in the region. Eurasia & Asia, and there especially Russia, is one of the key strategic growth areas for Dufry due to its high development potential."

Julian Diaz added: "As we have mentioned many times, one of the key elements of our strategy is to combine the organic growth of the existing operations with new concessions mainly in emerging markets. This new contract strongly reinforces our commitment to this strategy."
